

### 1. Mission, Vision and Objectives of The Research Center:

#### 1.1. Mission:

The mission of the Ishik University Research Center is to facilitate innovative research to support both the objectives of Ishik University and the national development of the region and to link its academic resources with a range of parameters.

#### 1.2. Vision:

The Ishik University Research Center will be an academic research organization dedicated to advising, applying and facilitating high standards of science and social research practice for a wide variety of researchers within the university and across the community, region and national arenas; to be one of the top innovation center in the region.

#### 1.3. Objectives:

Objective research and consultation are provided through:

- Partnership: Establishing and developing research relationship, both within the university and with external researches, research centers locally, nationally and internationally.
- Research Excellence: designing and providing quality research by adhering to the highest ethical standards and professional best practices.



### 2. Scope of the Center:

The Research Center of Ishik University represents the highest level of the research infrastructure within the University and is important entity in achieving the goals and objectives of the University's research strategy. The center provides focused support for research, both within faculties and across faculties.



### 3. Establishment of the Center:

The Research Center of Ishik University was established by decision of the University Council, meeting no.20 degree no.04 on December 17<sup>th</sup> 2017. The Center works toward the improvements of the research quality and knowledge productions of Ishik University.



### 4. The Director of the Research Center

The role of the director is to:

- 1- Manage the affairs of the research center,
- 2- Guide its strategic development,
- 3- Be the formal channel of communication between the Senior Officers of the University and the research center,
- 4- Represent the Center in the national and international events and activities,
- 5- Recommend the Research Centre Coordinators.
- 6- Approving the participation of the members in the national and international events.

Research center director will be approved by the university council on the recommendation of the vice-president. Prior to making the recommendation, the vice president should consult with the members of the research center.

The period of Office of the Director shall normally be four years. A person who has already held office as a Director shall be eligible for reappointment.

The director of the research center should meet the following requirements:

- 1- Has a PhD Degree.
- 2- Has the Academic Tile of "Assistant Professor" or higher.
- 3- Has 5+ years' experience in the Academic and Research Fields.

The Director of the Research Center has all the rights and privileges which the Head of Academic Department has.



### 5. The Research Center Representatives:

The responsibilities and the duties of each Research Center Representative:

- 1- To liaise between the Research Center and the Academic Departments
- 2- To coordinate the process of Preparing the Annual Departmental Research Plan.
- 3- To follow up the implementation of the Research Plan and to report the results to the Head and Dean.
- 4- To contact the Teaching Staff regarding their Research Progress.
- 5- To report the performed researches by the end of each academic year.
- 6- To encourage the academic work and to stimulate the research within the department.

- 7- To provide the needed data about the performed researches for NUR System requirements.
- 8- To contribute in preparing the Total Annual Research Report of Ishik University.
- 9- To coordinate the research projects.
- 10-To attend Research Center Committee meetings
- 11-To be available to listen to teaching staff' views and concerns regarding research issues
- 12-To impart the new decisions and regulations of the Research Center to the Academic Departments
- 13-To be acknowledged about the research procedures.



### 6. Duties of the Research Center:

- The aim of the center is to conduct national and foreign research, education and publication activities regarding different fields in cooperation with the relevant departments and divisions of the university.
- Provides an efficient, highly functional integration of education and research applications.
- Creating social and economic added-value out of knowledge and disseminating knowledge within society.
- Research Training Programs in the Education Sciences
- Provides valuable additional capabilities to the existing research infrastructure of the Faculty of Education Processes.
- The Center is engaged in highly effective multidisciplinary research programs.
- Bringing together researchers with expertise spanning advanced materials, basic sciences.
- The Center is encouraging collaboration with other universities and research institutions to further hone the skills of budding research specialists, which are sought in several advanced areas relevant to the interests of environment.
- Encouraging the training of the teaching staff that will conduct researches and publications regarding all the educations fields at the university, and preparing the necessary media and opportunities for this.
- Participating in and encouraging the researches and similar studies regarding different educations fields conducted by national and foreign public or private institutions within the scope of the relevant legislation.
- Arranging education programs, seminars, conferences, courses and national and international congresses regarding the relevant issues in order to increase information production and train quality human force at different levels, making proposals to the authorized university equipment and publications in order to give certificates to the participants at the end of such organizations.

- Establishing necessary laboratories in order to conduct relevant researches and practices, and providing other opportunities,
- Cooperating and exchanging knowledge with the similar national and foreign institutions and centers in order to provide the needed stuff.
- Performing other activities determined by the Director of the Center in light of the aims of the Center.
- Bringing together management scholars from the region.
- Open forum for local and international academics
- Establishment of a database of management articles published in high-ranking academic journals.
- Putting a police science research team.
- Taking a leadership role in the development of an international reputation for the center.
- Attracting research grant income, and other types of income, from a variety of sources, of a sufficient level that the center will become self-sustaining after the initial period.



### 7. Membership:

The members of a research center will be obliged to engage in research that advances the strategic development of the Center and will be researchers who are active across one or more of a range of indicators. These indicator will include publications, postgraduate, supervision, peer-review research funding, knowledge transfer activities and measures of peer esteem.

Application for membership of the center shall be considered through a procedure determined by the director. The continuation of membership of the center by existing members shall be reviewed on a regular basis by the director and discussion as to termination of the membership shall be made by the director following discussion with the vice president.



### 8. Affiliation of Research Center:

Research Center will be encouraged to become affiliated to the Center. Affiliation to a center will require that all members of the research center become members of the center. Application of affiliation to the center shall be considered by the director. The continuation of the affiliation to the center shall be reviewed on a regular basis by the center committee and as to termination of the affiliation shall be made by the director following discussion with the vice-president.



### 9. Research Strategy:

Research center will be required to have a research strategy. The strategy should address how the center will continue to enhance the quality of the research carried out within the university strategy and with relevant faculty and departmental research strategies. The strategy needs to be based on an objective analysis of the core competencies in the research themes and demonstrate how these themes affords the center a competitive advantage. The strategy needs to take into account the national and international environment in the research areas so as to best position the center to be competitive. Implementation plan with clear goals, objectives, milestones and deliverables. The deliverables should include details on how the research outputs will be translated.



### 10. Research Center Annual Report:

An annual report is a comprehensive report a center activities throughout the preceding year. This report provides a year-end overview of significant research findings, scientific honors and awards, and academic achievements, while financial statements demonstrate the center's fiscal health and stability. The report will be updated annually and include a detailed annual activities and budgets, and where appropriate a recruitment plan for the center. The recruitment plan must be aligned with the university strategic plan and have consideration to departmental recruitment linked to both research and teaching.



### 11. Research Center Meeting:

Research center meetings play a decisive role in the growth and development of the center and in instilling discipline among members. Center meetings are conducted weekly. It provides opportunity for members to discuss plans, map out activities, update each other on project status, and thresh out problems.



### 12. The Budget of the Research Center:

The research center is financed through the followings:

- 1- Budget allocated to the center form the Total University Budget.
- 2- Share of the income gained form the consultation and training services done by the center for other parties or companies.
- 3- Grants and financial assistances afforded to the center from national or international bodies.
- 4- Any income gained through activities held by the center.

### 2.6 - 4<sup>th</sup> National Innovation Competition in Engineering (NICE2018) "Targeting Smart Sustainable Innovations"

NICE (National Innovations Competition in Engineering) is a groundbreaking Engineering competition open to higher education students in Kurdistan Region. Project competition was held in six different categories: Computer Science and Engineering (Hardware & Software), Civil Engineering, Interior Design, and Architecture Engineering. There is, as well, one more category as Pasta Bridge (Spaghetti Bridge). The aims of the competition are to explore the ability of the students and provide a platform for the students to present their projects to the markets and exchange ideas on the



developments in the field of engineering. The chosen theme is aligned to the UN's 17 Sustainable Development Goals aimed at tackling the challenges of sustainable development from local to global level. More than 150 projects were presented by 400 students. More than 60 precious jury members evaluated these projects and selected the Winners. All participants got certificates of participation and the top three winners from each category got medals and a money award. The organization provided students with a chance to establish communication with each other to discuss their current work as well as to be encouraged in future projects. The competition was held among twenty different institutes and universities of Kurdistan and Iraq as follows:

#### **Project One**

#### **Project Title:**

Isolation and Identification of Bioactive Compounds and Pharmacological Studies of Iris Persica L.

Author(s): Prof. Dr. Faiq Hussain

#### **Abstract:**

Genus Iris (Iredaceae) comprise over 300 species; 12 of them are present in Iraq. Iris persica has been used in Kurdish traditional medicine for the treatment of wound inflammation and tumor. However, chemical and biological aspects of I. persica have not yet been investigated. Dry flowers, bulbs and rhizomes of I. persica will exhaustively extracting by maceration at room temperature, solvent of increasing polarity: hexane, methanol, methanol/water 70:30. Chlorophylls will remove from the methanolic extract of flowers by filtration on a C-18 reversed phase column. Subsequently, the methanolic extracts of the flowers, bulbs and rhizomes will separately fractionate by repetitive preparative MPLC, on C-18 reversed phase, to afford bioactive compounds.

#### **Project Two**

#### **Project Title:**

#### Comparative Study f Oral Candidiasis in Cancer and Pediatric Patients

Author(s): Dr. Karzan Mohammed

#### **Abstract:**

The yeast candida albicans is among the most common opportunistic pathogens in immunocompromised patients. Cancer causalities undergo chemotherapy are suffering from overgrowth of Candida albicans which can cause life threatening infections. The incidence of the oral candidiasis among early born and young children is high in this region. The complication in fungal infection are to be considered while chemotherapy is given to cancer patients.

Nevertheless, children who are admitted to hospital for serious diseases are under threat of opportunistic infection by Candida. This study will shed light on the incidence, biofilm aggressiveness of the yeast candida albicans that may contribute to the life threats and mortality of pediatrics and cancer children. Neglecting fungal treatment in parallel with other treatments may put life of patients under risk due to the complications that they can cause.

Analysis of Electron Transport Coefficient in SiH<sub>4</sub> Gas using Boltzmann equation in the Presence of Applied Electric Field

#### **Abstract:**

Electron swarm motion has been calculated using two term solution Boltzmann equation and swarm parameters have been evaluated for electrons in pure monosilane (SiH4) for a wide range of E/N varying from 1 x  $10_{-18}$  V.cm<sub>2</sub> < E/N <  $1x10_{-14}$  V.cm<sub>2</sub>. Comparison has been made with the experimental results for the ionization coefficient, the drift velocity, characteristic energy, mean electron energy ... etc. A set of electron molecule collisions has been assembled for monosilane gas which gave a good fit between the calculated and experimental values over the entire E/N range. The calculated distribution functions are found to be remarkably non-Maxwellian, having energy variations which reflect the important electron / molecule energy exchange astic collisions are given as function of E/N for SiH<sub>4</sub> gas.

#### **Abstract:**

Electron swarm motion has been calculated using a Boltzmann transport equation in pure SF6 and CCl<sub>2</sub>F<sub>2</sub> for a wide range of E/N from 100 Td to 800 Td. Comparison has been made with the experimental results for the ionization coefficient and drift velocity. The dielectric strength, the reduced effective ionization coefficient and attachment coefficient of an electronegative gas are calculated. The calculated distribution functions are found to be non-Maxwellian, having energy variation which reflect the important electron molecule energy exchange processes. In addition, the percentage of energy lost by different type of elastic and inelastic collisions are given as function of E/N.
